But take diligent heed to do **the commandment and the Torah**, which Moses  
the servant of the Lord charged you, to love the Lord your God, and to **walk  
in all his ways**, and to **keep his commandments**, and to **cleave to him**, and  
to **serve him** with all your heart and with all your soul: Yehoshua (Joshua) 22.5

1. Do the commandment and the Torah.  
Sh'mot (Exodus) 19.5-6
2. Walk in all His ways.  
Melachim alef (1 Kings) 2.3. Also Amos 3.3.
3. Keep (guard) His commandments.  
Sh'mot 15.26
4. Cleave to Him (be holy).  
D'varim 4.3-4
5. Serve Him (labor/obey).  
D'varim 6.13
