

The following are the 613 commandments and their source in scripture,
as enumerated by Maimonides:

301	Ex 25.8	To build a Temple	And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.
302	Ex 20.23	Not to build the altar with stones hewn by metal	u shall not make [anything to be] with Me--gods of silver or gods of gold you shall not make for yourselves.
303	Ex 20.26	Not to climb steps to the altar	Nor shall you go up by steps to My altar, that your nakedness may not be exposed on it.'
304	Lev 19.30	To show reverence to the Temple	"You shall keep My Sabbaths and reverence My sanctuary: I [am] the LORD.
305	Num 18.2	To guard the Temple area	Also bring with you your brethren of the tribe of Levi, the tribe of your father, that they may be joined with you and serve you while you and your sons are with you before the tabernacle of witness.
306	Num 18.5	Not to leave the Temple unguarded	And you shall attend to the duties of the sanctuary and the duties of the altar, that there may be no more wrath on the children of Israel.
307	Ex 30.31	To prepare the anointing oil	"And you shall speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'This shall be a holy anointing oil to Me throughout your generations.
308	Ex 30.32	Not to reproduce the anointing oil	It shall not be poured on man's flesh; nor shall you make [any other] like it, according to its composition. It [is] holy, [and] it shall be holy to you.
309	Ex 30.32	Not to anoint with anointing oil	It shall not be poured on man's flesh; nor shall you make [any other] like it, according to its composition. It [is] holy, [and] it shall be holy to you.
310	Ex 30.37	Not to reproduce the incense formula	But [as for] the incense which you shall make, you shall not make any for yourselves, according to its composition. It shall be to you holy for the LORD.
311	Ex 30.9	Not to burn anything on the Golden Altar besides incense	You shall not offer strange incense on it, or a burnt offering, or a grain offering; nor shall you pour a drink offering on it.
312	Num 7.9	The Levites must transport the ark on their shoulders	But to the sons of Kohath he gave none, because theirs [was] the service of the holy things, [which] they carried on their shoulders.
313	Ex 25.15	Not to remove the staves from the ark	The poles shall be in the rings of the ark; they shall not be taken from it.
314	Num 18.23	The Levites must work in the Temple	But the Levites shall perform the work of the tabernacle of meeting, and they shall bear their iniquity; [it shall be] a statute forever, throughout your generations, that among the children of Israel they shall have no inheritance.

315	Num 18.3	No Levite must do another's work of either a Kohen or a Levite	They shall attend to your needs and all the needs of the tabernacle; but they shall not come near the articles of the sanctuary and the altar, lest they die-- they and you also.
316	Lev 21.8	To dedicate the Kohen for service	Therefore you shall consecrate him, for he offers the bread of your God. He shall be holy to you, for I the LORD, who sanctify you, [am] holy.
317	Deut 18.6-8	The work of the Kohanim's shifts must be equal during holidays	"So if a Levite comes from any of your gates, from where he dwells among all Israel, and comes with all the desire of his mind to the place which the LORD chooses, then he may serve in the name of the LORD his God as all his brethren the Levites [do], who stand there before the LORD. They shall have equal portions to eat, besides what comes from the sale of his inheritance.
318	Ex 28.2	The Kohanim must wear their priestly garments during service	And you shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother, for glory and for beauty.
319	Ex 28.32	Not to tear the priestly garments	There shall be an opening for his head in the middle of it; it shall have a woven binding all around its opening, like the opening in a coat of mail, so that it does not tear.
320	Ex 28.28	The Kohen Gadol 's breastplate must not be loosened from the Efod	They shall bind the breastplate by means of its rings to the rings of the ephod, using a blue cord, so that it is above the intricately woven band of the ephod, and so that the breastplate does not come loose from the ephod.
321	Lev 10.9	A Kohen must not enter the Temple intoxicated	"Do not drink wine or intoxicating drink, you, nor your sons with you, when you go into the tabernacle of meeting, lest you die. [It shall be] a statute forever throughout your generations,
322	Lev 10.6	A Kohen must not enter the Temple with his head uncovered	And Moses said to Aaron, and to Eleazar and Ithamar, his sons, "Do not uncover your heads nor tear your clothes, lest you die, and wrath come upon all the people. But let your brethren, the whole house of Israel, bewail the burning which the LORD has kindled.
323	Lev 10.6	A Kohen must not enter the Temple with torn clothes	And Moses said to Aaron, and to Eleazar and Ithamar, his sons, "Do not uncover your heads nor tear your clothes, lest you die, and wrath come upon all the people. But let your brethren, the whole house of Israel, bewail the burning which the LORD has kindled.
324	Lev 16.2	A Kohen must not enter the Temple indiscriminately	and the LORD said to Moses: "Tell Aaron your brother not to come at just any time into the Holy Place inside the veil, before the mercy seat which is on the ark, lest he die; for I will appear in the cloud above the mercy seat.

Lev 10.7

A Kohen must not leave the Temple during service

You shall not go out from the door of the tabernacle of meeting, lest you die, for the anointing oil of the LORD [is] upon you." And they did according to the word of Moses.
