

The following are the 613 commandments and their source in scripture,
as enumerated by Maimonides:

451	Lev 14.9	The metzora must shave off all his hair prior to purification	But on the seventh day he shall shave all the hair off his head and his beard and his eyebrows--all his hair he shall shave off. He shall wash his clothes and wash his body in water, and he shall be clean.
452	Lev 13.47	Carry out the laws of tzara'at of clothing	"Also, if a garment has a leprous plague in it, [whether it is] a woolen garment or a linen garment,
453	Lev 14.34	Carry out the laws of tzara'at of houses	"When you have come into the land of Canaan, which I give you as a possession, and I put the leprous plague in a house in the land of your possession,
454	Lev 15.19	Observe the laws of menstrual impurity	'If a woman has a discharge, [and] the discharge from her body is blood, she shall be set apart seven days; and whoever touches her shall be unclean until evening.
455	Lev 12.2	Observe the laws of impurity caused by childbirth	"Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'If a woman has conceived, and borne a male child, then she shall be unclean seven days; as in the days of her customary impurity she shall be unclean.
456	Lev 15.25	Observe the laws of impurity caused by a woman's running issue	'If a woman has a discharge of blood for many days, other than at the time of her [customary] impurity, or if it runs beyond her [usual time of] impurity, all the days of her unclean discharge shall be as the days of her [customary] impurity. She [shall be] unclean.
457	Lev 15.3	Observe the laws of impurity caused by a man's running issue (irregular ejaculation of infected semen)	And this shall be his uncleanness in regard to his discharge--whether his body runs with his discharge, or his body is stopped up by his discharge, it is his uncleanness.
458	Lev 11.39	Observe the laws of impurity caused by a dead beast	'And if any animal which you may eat dies, he who touches its carcass shall be unclean until evening.
459	Lev 11.29	Observe the laws of impurity caused by the eight shratzim (insects) [lit. creeping things]	'These also [shall be] unclean to you among the creeping things that creep on the earth: the mole, the mouse, and the large lizard after its kind;
460	Lev 15.16	Observe the laws of impurity of a seminal emission (regular ejaculation, with normal semen)	'If any man has an emission of semen, then he shall wash all his body in water, and be unclean until evening.
461	Lev 11.34	Observe the laws of impurity concerning liquid and solid foods	in such a vessel, any edible food upon which water falls becomes unclean, and any drink that may be drunk from it becomes unclean.

462	Lev 15.16	Every impure person must immerse himself in a Mikvah to become pure	'If any man has an emission of semen, then he shall wash all his body in water, and be unclean until evening.
463	Ex 21.28	The court must judge the damages incurred by a goring ox	"If an ox gores a man or a woman to death, then the ox shall surely be stoned, and its flesh shall not be eaten; but the owner of the ox [shall be] acquitted.
464	Ex 22.5	The court must judge the damages incurred by an animal eating	If a man shall cause a field or vineyard to be eaten, and shall put in his beast, and shall feed in another man's field; of the best of his own field, and of the best of his own vineyard, shall he make restitution.
465	Ex 21.33	The court must judge the damages incurred by a pit	"And if a man opens a pit, or if a man digs a pit and does not cover it, and an ox or a donkey falls in it,
466	Ex 22.6	The court must judge the damages incurred by fire	If fire break out, and catch in thorns, so that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed [therewith]; he that kindled the fire shall surely make restitution.
467	Lev 19.11	Not to steal money stealthily	Ye shall not steal, neither deal falsely, neither lie one to another.
468	Ex 22.4	The court must implement punitive measures against the thief	If the theft be certainly found in his hand alive, whether it be ox, or ass, or sheep; he shall restore double.
469	Lev 19.36	Each individual must ensure that his scales and weights are accurate	Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: I [am] the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt.
470	Lev 19.35	Not to commit injustice with scales and weights	Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment, in meteyard, in weight, or in measure.
471	Deut 25.13	Not to possess inaccurate scales and weights even if they are not for use	Thou shalt not have in thy bag divers weights, a great and a small.
472	Deut 19.14	Not to move a boundary marker to steal someone's property	"You shall not remove your neighbor's landmark, which the men of old have set, in your inheritance which you will inherit in the land that the LORD your God is giving you to possess.
473	Ex 20.13	Not to kidnap	"You shall not murder. (also Deut 24.7) If a man be found stealing any of his brethren of the children of Israel, and maketh merchandise of him, or selleth him; then that thief shall die; and thou shalt put evil away from among you.
474	Lev 19.13	Not to rob openly	Thou shalt not defraud thy neighbour, neither rob [him]: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.
475	Lev 19.13	Not to withhold wages or fail to repay a debt	Thou shalt not defraud thy neighbour, neither rob [him]: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.
