26	Ex 22.27	Not to blaspheme	For that [is] his only covering, it [is] his garment for his skin. What will he sleep in? And it will be that when he cries to Me, I will hear, for I [am] gracious.
27	Ex 20.5	Not to worship idols in the manner they are worshiped	you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me,
28	Ex 20.5	Not to worship idols in the four ways we worship God	you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me,
29	Ex 20.4	Not to make an idol for yourself	"You shall not make for yourself a carved image--any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth;
30	Lev 19.4	Not to make an idol for others	'Do not turn to idols, nor make for yourselves molded gods: I [am] the LORD your God.
31	Ex 20.20	Not to make human forms even for decorative purposes	And Moses said to the people, "Do not fear; for God has come to test you, and that His fear may be before you, so that you may not sin."
32	Ex 23.13	Not to turn a city to idolatry	"And in all that I have said to you, be circumspect and make no mention of the name of other gods, nor let it be heard from your mouth.
33	Deut 13.17	To burn a city that has turned to idol worship	So none of the accursed things shall remain in your hand, that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of His anger and show you mercy, have compassion on you and multiply you, just as He swore to your fathers,
34	Deut 13.17	Not to rebuild it as a city	So none of the accursed things shall remain in your hand, that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of His anger and show you mercy, have compassion on you and multiply you, just as He swore to your fathers,
35	Deut 13.18	Not to derive benefit from it	because you have listened to the voice of the LORD your God, to keep all His commandments which I command you today, to do [what is] right in the eyes of the LORD your God.

36	Deut 13.12	Not to missionize an individual to idol worship	"If you hear someone in one of your cities, which the LORD your God gives you to dwell in, saying,
			but you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people.
37	Deut 13.9	Not to love the idolater	but you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people.
38	Deut 13.9	Not to cease hating the idolater	but you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people.
39	Deut 13.9	Not to save the idolater	but you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people.
40	Deut 13.9	Not to say anything in the idolater's defense	but you shall surely kill him; your hand shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people.
41	Deut 13.9	Not to refrain from incriminating the idolater	then you shall inquire, search out, and ask diligently. And [if it is] indeed true [and] certain [that] such an abomination was committed among you,
42	Deut 13.14	Not to prophesize in the name of idolatry	You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear Him, and keep His commandments and obey His voice; you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him.
43	Deut 13.4	Not to listen to a false prophet	But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.'
44	Deut 18.20	Not to prophesize falsely in the name of God	when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that [is] the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him.
45	Deut 18.22	Not to be afraid of killing the false prophet	"And in all that I have said to you, be circumspect and make no mention of the name of other gods, nor let it be heard from your mouth.
46	Ex 23.13	Not to swear in the name of an idol	'Give no regard to mediums and familiar spirits; do not seek after them, to be defiled by them: I [am] the LORD your God.
47	Lev 19.31	Not to perform ov (medium)	

48	Lev 19.31	Not to perform <i>yidoni</i> ("magical seer")	'Give no regard to mediums and familiar spirits; do not seek after them, to be defiled by them: I [am] the LORD your God.
49	Lev 18.21	Not to pass your children through the fire to Molech	And you shall not let any of your descendants pass through [the fire] to Molech, nor shall you profane the name of your God: I [am] the LORD.
50	Deut 16.22	Not to erect a pillar in a public place of worship	You shall not set up a sacred pillar, which the LORD your God hates.
