

The following are the 613 commandments and their source in scripture,
as enumerated by Maimonides:

576	Ex 20.16	Not to testify falsely	"You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
577	Deut 19.19	Punish the false witnesses as they tried to punish the defendant	then you shall do to him as he thought to have done to his brother; so you shall put away the evil from among you.
578	Deut 17.11	Act according to the ruling of the Sanhedrin	According to the sentence of the law in which they instruct you, according to the judgment which they tell you, you shall do; you shall not turn aside [to] the right hand or [to] the left from the sentence which they pronounce upon you.
579	Deut 17.11	Not to deviate from the word of the Sanhedrin	According to the sentence of the law in which they instruct you, according to the judgment which they tell you, you shall do; you shall not turn aside [to] the right hand or [to] the left from the sentence which they pronounce upon you.
580	Deut 12.32	Not to add to the Torah commandments or their oral explanations	"Whatever I command you, be careful to observe it; you shall not add to it nor take away from it.
581	Deut 12.32	Not to diminish from the Torah any commandments, in whole or in part	"Whatever I command you, be careful to observe it; you shall not add to it nor take away from it.
582	Ex 21.17	Not to curse your father and mother	"And he who curses his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.
583	Ex 21.15	Not to strike your father and mother	"And he who strikes his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.
584	Ex 20.12	Respect your father or mother	"Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.
585	Lev 19.3	Fear your father or mother	"Every one of you shall revere his mother and his father, and keep My Sabbaths: I [am] the LORD your God.
586	Deut 21.18	Not to be a rebellious son	"If a man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey the voice of his father or the voice of his mother, and [who], when they have chastened him, will not heed them, And Aaron said to Moses, "Look, this day they have offered their sin offering and their burnt offering before the LORD, and such things have befallen me! [If] I had eaten the sin offering today, would it have been accepted in the sight of the LORD?"
587	Lev 10.19	Mourn for relatives	
588	Lev 21.11	The High Priest must not defile himself for any relative	nor shall he go near any dead body, nor defile himself for his father or his mother;
589	Lev 21.11	The High Priest must not enter under the same roof as a corpse	nor shall he go near any dead body, nor defile himself for his father or his mother;

590	Lev 21.1	A Kohen must not defile himself (by going to funerals or cemeteries) for anyone except relatives	And the LORD said to Moses, "Speak to the priests, the sons of Aaron, and say to them: 'None shall defile himself for the dead among his people,
591	Deut 17.15	Appoint a king from Israel	you shall surely set a king over you whom the LORD your God chooses; [one] from among your brethren you shall set as king over you; you may not set a foreigner over you, who [is] not your brother.
592	Deut 17.15	Not to appoint a foreigner	you shall surely set a king over you whom the LORD your God chooses; [one] from among your brethren you shall set as king over you; you may not set a foreigner over you, who [is] not your brother.
593	Deut 17.17	The king must not have too many wives	Neither shall he multiply wives for himself, lest his heart turn away; nor shall he greatly multiply silver and gold for himself.
594	Deut 17.16	The king must not have too many horses	But he shall not multiply horses for himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt to multiply horses, for the LORD has said to you, 'You shall not return that way again.'
595	Deut 17.17	The king must not have too much silver and gold	Neither shall he multiply wives for himself, lest his heart turn away; nor shall he greatly multiply silver and gold for himself.
596	Deut 20.17	Destroy the seven Canaanite nations	but you shall utterly destroy them: the Hittite and the Amorite and the Canaanite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite, just as the LORD your God has commanded you,
597	Deut 20.16	Not to let any of them remain alive	"But of the cities of these peoples which the LORD your God gives you [as] an inheritance, you shall let nothing that breathes remain alive,
598	Deut 25.19	Wipe out the descendants of Amalek	Therefore it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from your enemies all around, in the land which the LORD your God is giving you to possess [as] an inheritance, [that] you will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. You shall not forget.
599	Deut 25.17	Remember what Amalek did to the Jewish people	"Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you were coming out of Egypt,
600	Deut 25.19	Not to forget Amalek's atrocities and ambush on our journey from Egypt in the desert	Therefore it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from your enemies all around, in the land which the LORD your God is giving you to possess [as] an inheritance, [that] you will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. You shall not forget.
