

The following are the 613 commandments and their source in scripture,
as enumerated by Maimonides:

176	Lev 11.2	To examine the signs of animals to distinguish between kosher and non-kosher	"Speak to the children of Israel, saying, 'These are the animals which you may eat among all the animals that are on the earth:
177	Deut 14.11	To examine the signs of fowl to distinguish between kosher and non-kosher	"All clean birds you may eat.
178	Lev 11.9	To examine the signs of fish to distinguish between kosher and non-kosher	'These you may eat of all that [are] in the water: whatever in the water has fins and scales, whether in the seas or in the rivers--that you may eat.
179	Lev 11.21	To examine the signs of locusts to distinguish between kosher and non-kosher	Yet these you may eat of every flying insect that creeps on [all] fours: those which have jointed legs above their feet with which to leap on the earth. Nevertheless these you shall not eat among those that chew the cud or those that have cloven hooves: the camel, because it chews the cud but does not have cloven hooves, is unclean to you;
180	Lev 11.4	Not to eat non-kosher animals	
181	Lev 11.13	Not to eat non-kosher fowl	'And these you shall regard as an abomination among the birds; they shall not be eaten, they [are] an abomination: the eagle, the vulture, the buzzard,
182	Lev 11.11	Not to eat non-kosher fish	They shall be an abomination to you; you shall not eat their flesh, but you shall regard their carcasses as an abomination.
183	Deut 14.19	Not to eat non-kosher flying insects	"Also every creeping thing that flies is unclean for you; they shall not be eaten.
184	Lev 11.41	Not to eat non-kosher creatures that crawl on land	'And every creeping thing that creeps on the earth [shall be] an abomination. It shall not be eaten.
185	Lev 11.44	Not to eat non-kosher maggots	For I [am] the LORD your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I [am] holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth.
186	Lev 11.43	Not to eat worms found in fruit on the ground	You shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creeps; nor shall you make yourselves unclean with them, lest you be defiled by them.
187	Lev 11.43	Not to eat creatures that live in water other than (kosher) fish	You shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creeps; nor shall you make yourselves unclean with them, lest you be defiled by them.

188	Deut 14.21	Not to eat the meat of an animal that died without ritual slaughter	"You shall not eat anything that dies [of itself]; you may give it to the alien who [is] within your gates, that he may eat it, or you may sell it to a foreigner; for you [are] a holy people to the LORD your God. "You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk.
189	Ex 21.28	Not to benefit from an ox condemned to be stoned	"If an ox gores a man or a woman to death, then the ox shall surely be stoned, and its flesh shall not be eaten; but the owner of the ox [shall be] acquitted.
190	Ex 22.31	Not to eat meat of an animal that was mortally wounded	"And you shall be holy men to Me: you shall not eat meat torn [by beasts] in the field; you shall throw it to the dogs.
191	Deut 12.23	Not to eat a limb torn off a living creature	Only be sure that you do not eat the blood, for the blood [is] the life; you may not eat the life with the meat.
192	Lev 3.17	Not to eat blood	'[This shall be] a perpetual statute throughout your generations in all your dwellings: you shall eat neither fat nor blood.' "
193	Lev 3.17	Not to eat certain fats of clean animals	'[This shall be] a perpetual statute throughout your generations in all your dwellings: you shall eat neither fat nor blood.' "
194	Gen 32.32	Not to eat the sinew of the thigh	Therefore to this day the children of Israel do not eat the muscle that shrank, which [is] on the hip socket, because He touched the socket of Jacob's hip in the muscle that shrank.
195	Ex 23.19	Not to eat meat and milk cooked together	The first of the firstfruits of your land you shall bring into the house of the LORD your God. You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk.
196	Ex 34.26	Not to cook meat and milk together	"The first of the firstfruits of your land you shall bring to the house of the LORD your God. You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk."
197	Lev 23.14	Not to eat bread from new grain before the Omer	You shall eat neither bread nor parched grain nor fresh grain until the same day that you have brought an offering to your God; [it shall be] a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.
198	Lev 23.14	Not to eat parched grains from new grain before the Omer	You shall eat neither bread nor parched grain nor fresh grain until the same day that you have brought an offering to your God; [it shall be] a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.
199	Lev 23.14	Not to eat ripened grains from new grain before the Omer	You shall eat neither bread nor parched grain nor fresh grain until the same day that you have brought an offering to your God; [it shall be] a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.
200	Lev 19.23	Not to eat fruit of a tree during its first three years	'When you come into the land, and have planted all kinds of trees for food, then you shall count their fruit as uncircumcised. Three years it shall be as uncircumcised to you. [It] shall not be eaten.
