

The following are the 613 commandments and their source in scripture,
as enumerated by Maimonides:

201	Deut 22.9	Not to eat diverse seeds planted in a vineyard	"You shall not sow your vineyard with different kinds of seed, lest the yield of the seed which you have sown and the fruit of your vineyard be defiled.
202	Lev 22.15	Not to eat untithed fruits	They shall not profane the holy [offerings] of the children of Israel, which they offer to the LORD,
203	Deut 32.38	Not to drink wine poured in service to idols	Who ate the fat of their sacrifices, [And] drank the wine of their drink offering? Let them rise and help you, [And] be your refuge.
204	Deut 12.21	To ritually slaughter an animal before eating it	If the place where the LORD your God chooses to put His name is too far from you, then you may slaughter from your herd and from your flock which the LORD has given you, just as I have commanded you, and you may eat within your gates as much as your heart desires.
205	Lev 22.28	Not to slaughter an animal and its offspring on the same day	[Whether it is] a cow or ewe, do not kill both her and her young on the same day.
206	Lev 17.13	To cover the blood (of a slaughtered beast or fowl) with earth	"Whatever man of the children of Israel, or of the strangers who dwell among you, who hunts and catches any animal or bird that may be eaten, he shall pour out its blood and cover it with dust;
207	Deut 22.6	To send away the mother bird before taking its children	"If a bird's nest happens to be before you along the way, in any tree or on the ground, with young ones or eggs, with the mother sitting on the young or on the eggs, you shall not take the mother with the young;
208	Deut 22.7	To release the mother bird if she was taken from the nest	you shall surely let the mother go, and take the young for yourself, that it may be well with you and [that] you may prolong [your] days.
209	Lev 19.12	Not to swear falsely in God's Name	And you shall not swear by My name falsely, nor shall you profane the name of your God: I [am] the LORD.
210	Ex 20.7	Not to take God's Name in vain	"You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.
211	Lev 19.11	Not to deny possession of something entrusted to you	"You shall not steal, nor deal falsely, nor lie to one another.
212	Lev 19.11	Not to swear in denial of a monetary claim	"You shall not steal, nor deal falsely, nor lie to one another.
213	Deut 10.20	To swear in God's Name to confirm the truth when deemed necessary by court	You shall fear the LORD your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name.

214	Deut 23.23	To fulfill what was uttered and to do what was avowed	That which has gone from your lips you shall keep and perform, for you voluntarily vowed to the LORD your God what you have promised with your mouth.
215	Num 30.3	Not to break oaths or vows	"Or if a woman makes a vow to the LORD, and binds [herself] by some agreement while in her father's house in her youth,
216	Num 30.3	For oaths and vows annulled, there are the laws of annulling vows explicit in the Torah	"Or if a woman makes a vow to the LORD, and binds [herself] by some agreement while in her father's house in her youth, 'All the days of the vow of his separation no razor shall come upon his head; until the days are fulfilled for which he separated himself to the LORD, he shall be holy. [Then] he shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow.
217	Num 6.5	The Nazir must let his hair grow	'All the days of the vow of his separation no razor shall come upon his head; until the days are fulfilled for which he separated himself to the LORD, he shall be holy. [Then] he shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow.

219	Num 6.3	He must not drink wine, wine mixtures, or wine vinegar	he shall separate himself from wine and similar drink; he shall drink neither vinegar made from wine nor vinegar made from similar drink; neither shall he drink any grape juice, nor eat fresh grapes or raisins.
220	Num 6.3	He must not eat fresh grapes	he shall separate himself from wine and similar drink; he shall drink neither vinegar made from wine nor vinegar made from similar drink; neither shall he drink any grape juice, nor eat fresh grapes or raisins.
221	Num 6.3	He must not eat raisins	he shall separate himself from wine and similar drink; he shall drink neither vinegar made from wine nor vinegar made from similar drink; neither shall he drink any grape juice, nor eat fresh grapes or raisins.
222	Num 6.4	He must not eat grape seeds	All the days of his separation he shall eat nothing that is produced by the grapevine, from seed to skin.
223	Num 6.4	He must not eat grape skins	All the days of his separation he shall eat nothing that is produced by the grapevine, from seed to skin.
224	Num 6.6	He must not be under the same roof as a corpse	All the days that he separates himself to the LORD he shall not go near a dead body.
225	Num 6.7	He must not come into contact with the dead	He shall not make himself unclean even for his father or his mother, for his brother or his sister, when they die, because his separation to God [is] on his head.
